## Working across society, politics, and institutions

A programme with an interdisciplinary ethos designed to offer an integrated view of politics as an interaction between society and institutions, and to train individuals capable of analyzing politics, and managing and implementing public policies. This programme provides a unique combination of theoretical knowledge and concrete operational tools to address the challenges of governance and administration in an increasingly complex world. A distinctive feature is the practical, application-oriented approach to knowledge, thanks to workshops developed in cooperation with public bodies and businesses. Thus, students learn how society formulates demands that are elaborated by politics, producing policies. They also develop analytical and management skills that are essential for leadership roles within institutions, as well as for strategic advisory roles for private bodies and companies. In addition, for those interested in research, the programme provides a solid foundation for pursuing doctoral studies.





# A Bridge between University and the World of Work

Luiss supports students and graduates in building a career path and finding a job, thanks to a wide network of relationships with key professional entities. The services offered include:

- **Career Guidance:**
  - **one-on-one meetings:** sessions to create career action plans, review CVs and cover letters, prepare for interviews and explore career paths;
  - **career workshops:** seminars with HR experts, to understand the needs of the market, discover the labour market and better prepare for employment after graduation;
  - **more than 130 summer curricular internships,** which allow students to acquire specific and transversal skills, improve employability, enrich their CVs and obtain possible ECTS credits;
  - **collecting and sharing with employers of the CVs** of graduate students;
  - **internship and job opportunities.**
- **Events for all students,** such as the University's Career Days, open to employers from all sectors and countries.

- **Events with Employers:** In 2023, more than **70 networking and recruiting events** involving more than **330 employers and 87 Luiss graduates** were organised.

Also thanks to these activities, the employment rate of Luiss graduates stands at 96% one year after graduation, rising to 98% after five years. The average waiting time between graduation and first employment is only one month.

## Luiss Alumni

Luiss Alumni represent a network of personal and professional relationships and opportunities composed of over 60,000 people worldwide. This community is always active in a collaboration with the University, which includes various programmes and initiatives.

In addition, graduates can access exclusive services, such as the University Library, an institutional e-mail address, special rates granted by shops, education providers, sports clubs, hotels, and much more.

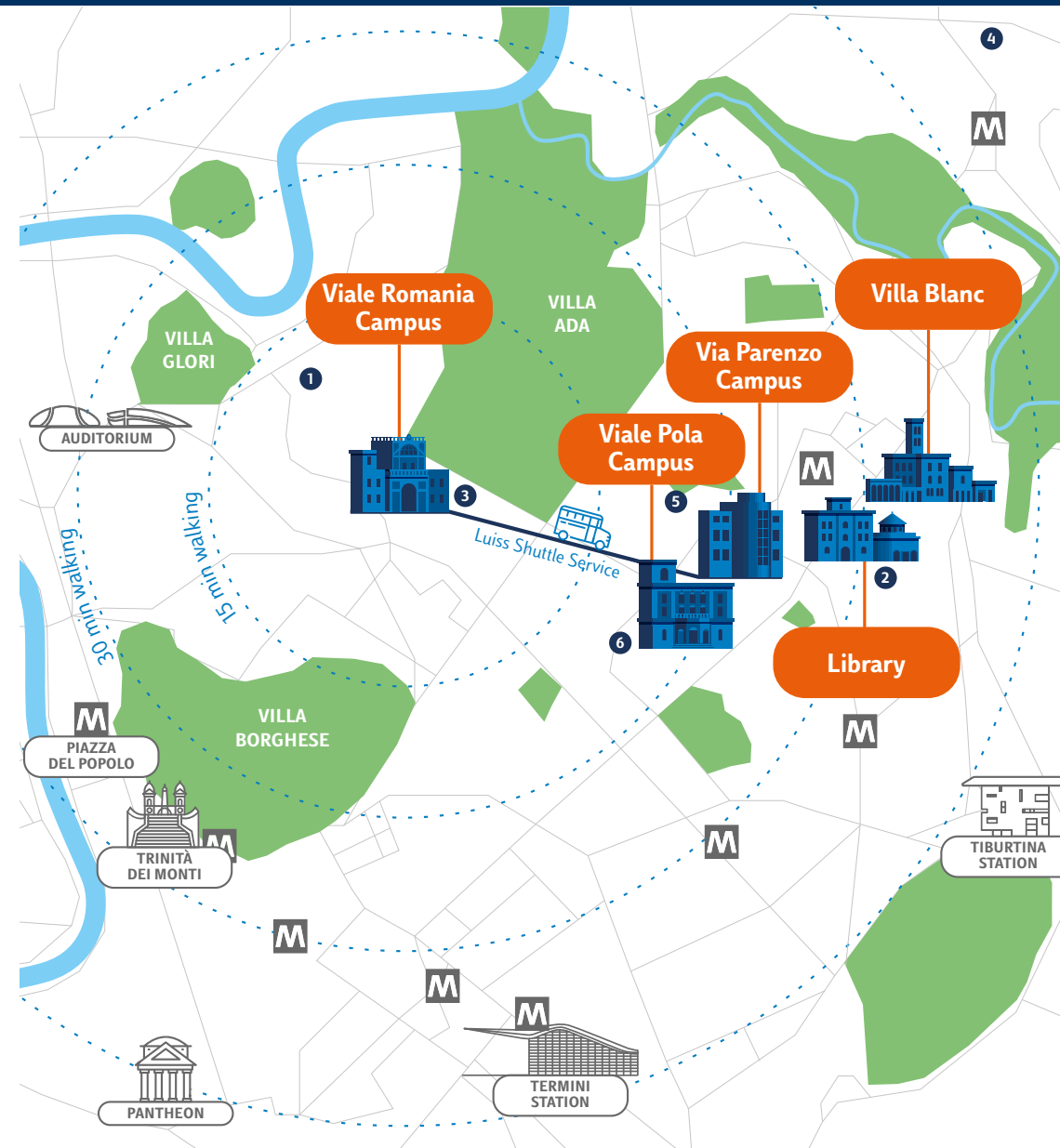

# Luiss Campuses



## VIALE POLA CAMPUS

The campus at Viale Pola 12 stands on what remains of Villa Alberoni, a large property owned by Cardinal Giulio Alberoni, which in 1722 extended to more than 27 hectares. It is the University's historical and original headquarters and houses the offices of the President, the Rector and the General Manager.

In addition, it hosts part of the Undergraduate School's teaching activities, in particular those of the Law degree programme and the first years of the Global Law, Scienze Politiche and Politics: Philosophy and Economics degree programmes, as well as the 'Massimo Baldini' School of Journalism and postgraduate programmes.

## VIALE ROMANIA CAMPUS

The campus at Viale Romania 32 represents a portion of a much larger property belonging to Count de Heritz, who, in the second half of the 19<sup>th</sup> century, combined several suburban villas into a single estate. After a major conservative and functional restoration of the buildings and the park, the campus has been hosting teaching and research activities since 2007. The campus also features creative spaces such as Luiss

Language Café and Luiss Loft, as well as Radio Luiss. The campus hosts the Undergraduate School's degree programmes in Economics and Business, Management and Artificial Intelligence, Economia e Management, and Business Administration, as well as the second and third years of the Political Science and Politics: Philosophy and Economics degree programmes. In addition, the campus hosts all the Graduate School's programmes.



# Luiss Campuses



## VIA PARENZO CAMPUS

The campus at Via Parenzo 11 is the most complex and significant work realised in the 1930s by Pietro Aschieri. It housed a workhouse for the war blind and was acquired by Luiss in the 1980s.

The campus is home to Luiss Open Lounge and the location where most of the teaching activities of the Law degree programme and part of those of the Global Law, Political Science and Politics: Philosophy and Economics degree programmes take place.

## LIBRARY

The library, located at Via di Santa Costanza 53 and adjacent to the Mausoleum of Santa Costanza, covers an area of over 1,200 square metres and houses several reading and reference rooms, as well as a garden and a refreshment area.

The library specialises in the social sciences, in particular, Law, Economics, and Political Science, and is a point of reference for the University's research and academic output, offering constant support for teaching programmes.





# Campus Life

## Tutoring and Buddy Programme

Through its Tutoring service, Luiss supports students throughout their university studies. Tutors offer assistance and guidance during students' academic path in orientation and choices, in the organisation of studies and in the management of relations with faculty and the University's various offices.

The service is provided both in-person, in the tutor rooms at Viale Romania and Via Parenzo, and online, by appointment.

The University also runs the Luiss Buddy Programme, with the aim of fostering integration into the university community and facilitating dialogue with the teaching environment and administrative staff.

## Cultural Activities

Luiss offers students the opportunity to complement their academic education with various cultural activities: among the most popular programmes are the Theatre Workshop and the Guided Tours project, which allow students to become ambassadors of the historical, artistic and architectural treasures of our University.

## Sport

Luiss offers several opportunities to engage in sports:

- join an AS Luiss team to competitively practice a sport among athletics, basketball, rowing, cycling, horseback riding, golf, swimming, padel, volleyball, rugby, skiing, tennis and sailing;
- join the Sports School, to take classes in athletics, rowing, cheerleading, golf, swimming, padel, taekwondo, tango, tennis, sailing and yoga;
- participate in sports tournaments organized during the year open to students, faculty members, staff, and alumni.

## Medical Services

Luiss has the well-being and health of its student body at heart. For this reason, it provides various preventive medicine services and has signed agreements with specialised medical centres. Furthermore, within the Viale Romania campus, there is a Medical Consultation and Orientation Hub that offers a general consultation service, thanks to the presence of nationally renowned specialists in the areas of greatest bio-psychosocial impact. At the Viale Pola campus (or remotely) it is possible to avail of Luiss' ti Ascolta, a psychological counselling service.



# Campus Life

## Skills Development

Luiss offers an integrated educational experience, focused on the understanding of values, the improvement of personal skills and informed knowledge. For this reason, it affords students the opportunity to broaden the scope of their training and experience, giving them a chance for 'contamination' with what is different or still unknown. This is possible as early as Freshers' Week, an initiative dedicated to welcoming the first-year students of bachelor's, single cycle master's and master's degree programmes, where they can take part in various activities and workshops to develop their transversal skills. In addition, the following initiatives are worth mentioning:

- **Soft Skills Pathways:** compulsory activities on the themes of social responsibility and environmental and social sustainability;
- **Academic Gym:** hands-on, experiential extracurricular workshops facilitating the development of transversal, creative and digital skills;
- **VolontariaMENTE:** a project that, during the academic year and the summer period, enables students to undertake voluntary work with national and local associations in Rome;

- **Special projects** like the Legality and Merit project (initiated by Professor Paola Severino), which sees students become ambassadors of the values of legality and merit in high schools and juvenile detention centres.

## International Students Welcome Desk

Luiss provides comprehensive support to international students throughout the process of arriving in Rome. Our services include:

- invitation letter for study visa application;
- support in the visa application procedure to study in Italy;
- application or renewal of residence permit for study purposes;
- application for health insurance policy and registration with the Italian Health Service;
- application for a tax code;
- opening of a bank account;
- registration with the Municipality of Rome.

There are two distinct procedures for admission to master's degree programmes.

## Direct admission based on certification
